

Sunnyvale Alliance Soccer Club Financial Assistance for Players

Players that are registered with Sunnyvale Alliance Soccer Club ("SASC") and incur additional expenses for cleats, uniforms, bags, equipment and tournaments can receive reimbursement for related expenses. In order to support players that might be in need of financial assistance, SASC has created a program to provide funding for related soccer expenses. A player may apply for payments of up to \$150 each soccer season that they are registered as a player on a SASC team.

In order to be eligible for this program the player must be currently registered on a SASC team, be in good standing, and have applied for and received a SASC scholarship from SCS for the current calendar year. Players that receive a SASC Scholarship from SCS in the spring need not reapply for one in the fall- SASC will transfer it over within the calendar year.

If a scholarship player receives a red card or game suspensions, the privilege of financial aid reimbursement may be revoked during that season. If a scholarship player receives multiple red cards and/or game suspensions they will become ineligible for scholarship benefits in future seasons, including payment of registration fee and expense reimbursements.

The following expenses are covered:

Uniforms, warm ups and bags ordered by competitive teams. There is a limit for reimbursement of one uniform set per calendar year.

Specific equipment required to play, such as shoes, shin guards, balls, and goalkeeper gloves for both comp and rec players. Cleats will be reimbursed up to \$80 and shin guards up to \$20. There are currently no SASC indoor or futsal teams, so none of those expenses can be reimbursed.

Tournament fees for the player and travel expenses for the tournament to include hotel for the player and auto mileage reimbursement if the family chooses to drive.

Coaches may apply in advance for funds for tournaments, or submit a reimbursement form with receipts. In the case of SASC uniform purchases, SASC will reimburse for a maximum of one uniform set each season. Players may purchase, and be reimbursed for, replacement pieces in subsequent seasons. Players will not be reimbursed for double uniform sets. In order to receive reimbursement for uniform purchases, the team/manager must obtain a written receipt of uniform purchase from the SASC uniform coordinator at the time of purchase.

Families that wish to receive a SASC Scholarship can apply for a scholarship to cover registration fees at Sunnyvale Community Services at 725 Kifer Rd. Sunnyvale. Approved scholarship forms must be submitted with the player's registration for the season. Scholarship forms will not be accepted as payment for checks returned by the bank for non-sufficient funds.

Scholarship players will receive a 20% discount at Soccer International and All-Star Soccer if they identify themselves as SASC Scholarship players.
