



## Competitive Teams Uniform Policy



All Sunnyvale Alliance Soccer Club (SASC) competitive teams are required to outfit their players in the SASC approved Competitive Team uniform as shown above.

Wearing of the SASC Competitive Team uniform is mandatory when an SASC competitive team is being photographed as a SASC team and/or representing SASC in an official match, including but not limited to annual Fun Day team photo sessions, tournament team photos, USSF, USYS, CYSA and US Club sanctioned Tournaments, Jamborees, and Playing Leagues.

The SASC Competitive Team uniform set includes:

- two jerseys – red/white stripes is the primary jersey, white is the alternate jersey
- one pair of black shorts with a white stripe on the sides/red piping
- two pair of socks – white with black stripes above the calf, or black with white stripes above the calf . Black socks will not be provided. (all players on the team must wear the same color socks)
- training t-shirt

This uniform set is available only through SASC, there are no other approved vendors.

Other than the SASC name on the front of the competitive team uniform jerseys, and player name (last or first), team name (e.g., PUMAS), and/or player number on the back of the competitive team jerseys, nothing else may be printed or sewn on an SASC competitive team jersey or shorts without prior approval from the SASC President and SASC Competitive Director.

Any violations of the SASC Competitive Teams Uniform Policy will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis by the SASC Board of Directors and appropriate actions taken.
