Competitive Teams Uniform Policy
Updated March 2025

All Sunnyvale Alliance Soccer Club (SASC) competitive teams are required to outfit their players in the SASC approved competitive team uniform. Wearing of the SASC competitive team uniform is mandatory when an SASC competitive team is representing SASC in official matches, annual SASC Annual Picture Day, any team photos at USSF, USYS, CYSA, and US Club sanctioned tournaments, jamborees, and playing leagues.

SASC will use official *Adidas* apparel provided exclusively through a club approved local vendor.

The SASC Competitive Team uniform set includes:

- Adidas Jersey
 - o Two jerseys Red/White stripes is the primary jersey, Black/Grey is the alternate jersey
- Adidas Shorts
 - One pair of Black shorts with White stripes on the sides
- Adidas Socks
 - One pair of socks Black with White stripes above the calf
 - o Additional Option Red with White stripes above the calf

Extra jerseys, shorts, socks, or other SASC approved apparel are available for purchase at an additional cost.

Other than the SASC patch on the front of the competitive team uniform jerseys, and the player number on the back of the competitive team jerseys, nothing else may be printed or sewn on an SASC competitive team jersey without prior approval from the SASC President and SASC Competitive Director. **No names of any kind are to appear on any of the jerseys.**

Periodically, the uniform style used by SASC will change. When a new style of uniform is introduced, a transition timeline will be set by SASC.

Any violations of the SASC Competitive Teams Uniform Policy will be reviewed on a case-by case basis by the SASC Board of Directors and appropriate actions will be taken.
